Yorktown Finishes 3rd

North Wins Girls' Swim Sectional

ANDERSON — Records fell like leaves plipped by an early frost Saturday afternoon as Muncie Northside won the Girls High School Sectional Swim Meet for the third time in the 13-team event held in the Anderson High School Pool.

Shaking off early challenges by Anderson's Indians, the Titans rolled up 283 points, with the home team second with 240. Yorktown's Tigers came on strong to finish third with 171 points.

Muncie Central finished eighth with 56 points, five tallies ahead of Jay County, with Delta winding up in twelfth place.

Anderson started with a rush, its 200-yard medley relay foursome outdistancing Northside's relayers by less than four-tenths of a percentage

point. Yorktown wound up third in the event and on the basis of state high school point standards, the Tigers join the Indians and Titans in the state finals next Friday and Saturday at Ball State University's pool.

The Indians, Titans and Tigers qualified both their relay foursomes for state action. In addition, Northside got six individual performers in 10 events eligible for further competition; Yorktown, four girls in four events; Anderson, two girls in three events; Muncie Central, one girl in two events; Connersville, one in two events; and Jay County, Madison Heights, and Richmond, one girl each.

During the afternoon, new records were set in the following events: 200 medley relay; 200 freestyle; 200 individual medley; 50 freestyle; 100 but-

terfly; 100 freestyle; 500 freestyle and 100 backstroke.

It was a Delaware County 1-2-3 finish in the 200 freestyle, with Nancy Darter, Northside, setting a new record, as she wound about two seconds in front of teammate E. Chico, with Yorktown's L. LaRue a close third.

Tami Ruemler of the Titans swam off and left the rest of the field in the 200 individual medley, setting a new record of 2:18.214 in the process. Sue Wulf, Anderson, was almost five seconds behind the winner, and narrowly edged cross town rival M. Ainsworth of Madison Heights for the second spot.

The 50 freestyle had a blanket finish with Anderson's N. Vargo, S. Fullhart, Central, and Pamela Garrett, Yorktown, finishing 1-2-3 and all qualifying for state action.

It was a ding-dong battle in the 500 freestyle between Alice Darter, Northside, and L. Hadley, Connersville. The two, quite alone at the finish, were clocked in times of 5:26.271 (new sectional record), and 5:27.130 respectively.

Ironically, two others qualified for state competition in this event on the basis of state standards. These were Nancy Darter and E. Chico, both of the Titans.

Jay County's K. McBride drew a standing ovation from appreciative fans during the diving finals. The Patriot athlete ran off with laurels in the event, compiling 428.28 points, far outdistancing the field.

Richmond joined Northside and Yorktown in next week's state meet on the strength of a bitterly fought 400 freestyle relay event. During the early going, Anderson was in a challenging position, but fell off to fourth when the Tigers, on the strength of clutch swimming by L. Rowan and C. Wulf, overcame the Indians in the battle for third.

The Titan foursome of L. Allardt, D. Beebe, E. Chico and N. Carter was

SOUTH BEND, Ind. (UPI) — Six-foot-nine Toby Knight scored 13 of his 17 points in the first half while Notre Dame piled up a 37-18 lead and the undefeated Irish rolled to a 93-56 victory over Valparaiso.

Irish freshman guard Rich Branning came off the bench to score 18 points and make five assists in only 20 minutes of action, mostly in the second half.

The Irish, now 3-0, jumped out to a 10-2 lead in the first three minutes of the game with two of the baskets by Knight. Valparaiso never got closer than within six points the rest of the way. After the Crusaders pulled within 10-12, Notre Dame reeled off eight straight points to take command.

Bruce Flowers scored 14 points and pulled down a game high 12 rebounds

Muncie Girls Swim Well at South Adams

BERNE — Alice Darter of North and Shelley Fullhart of Central led a strong Muncie contingent of girls' varsity swimmers that dominated the qualifying round of the South Adams sectional here Monday.

Muncie swimmers placed first in all but one event. The top six times from each race qualified for the championship race tonight, and the next six places will be in the consolation race.

Darter bettered her own state record in the 100-yard butterfly with a time of 1:05.2, to go with her first place time of 2:02 in the 200-yard freestyle. She was also a member of North's first place 400-yard freestyle relay team, which came home in a time of 4:07.

Fullhart finished first both times she hit the water in the individual events, claiming first in the 50-yard freestyle with a time of :26.6 and another blue ribbon for a winning time of :58.3 in the 100-yard freestyle. She also was a member of Central winning 200-yard medley relay team, which won with a time of 2:03.5.

Nine other Titan tankers qualified for championship races besides Darter. Lynn Allardt was second behind Darter in the 200-yard freestyle and the 100-yard butterfly. Emily Chico claimed third in the 200-yard freestyle and second in the 500-yard freestyle. Kris Peterson also had two firsts to her credit, with a time of 2:28.1 for first in the 200-yard individual medley and a clocking of 5:34.6 for the 500-yard freestyle.

Dorice Kelley was second in the 100-yard breaststroke and fourth in the 200-yard individual medley. Vicki Smith swam to a fifth in the 100-yard breaststroke and 10th in the 200-yard individual medley. Diana Beebe was second in the 50-yard freestyle and third in the 100-yard freestyle.

North's Sharon Anderson was fourth in both the 50- and 100-yard freestyle. Dimmick was fourth in the 100-yard backstroke and 12th in the 50 freestyle and teammate Karen Deek was second in the 100-yard backstroke and fifth in the 100-yard freestyle.

Central placed five girls in the final besides Fullhart. Julie Hall was first in the 100-yard backstroke with a time of 1:07.7 and second in the 200-yard individual medley. Sheryl Irving was third in the 50-yard freestyle and fourth in the 500-yard freestyle. Louise Kellison was third in the 100-yard breaststroke and fourth in the 100-yard butterfly. Tina Turney was fifth in the 100-yard backstroke and seventh in the 100-yard butterfly.

Three other Bearcat tankers qualified for the consolation races. Theresa Brown was eighth in the 100-yard breaststroke, Theresa Joy was 12th in the 200-yard individual medley and Jody Miller was ninth in the 200-yard freestyle.
