Swim leam riaces winth at State

"We cannot begin without praising Coach Bob Chico," said swim team co-captain Pat Samuels. "In all my years of athletics if there is one person who was most memorable it would definitely be Bob Chico. Coach Chico knows more about swimming and conditioning than anyone else."

The team finished ninth in state competition and third in the North Central Conference. Among state competitors was junior Adam Fero, who finished fourth in 100 freestyle (:46.83) and sixth in 200 freestyle (1:44.24). The 400 freestyle relay team of Greg Sissel, Samuels, Josh Dobbs and Fero placed sixth (3:14.25), while Mike Shelton placed 12th with 365.95 points in the diving competition.


"That's the first time in at least 15 years Cen-

tral has had a diver down there," said Chico. "Those five points kept us ahead of South Bend Riley. Without them we would have been tenth again."

According to co-captain Sissel, the team was extremely happy with the outcome of the sectional. Almost everyone dropped time in his event, which showed the hard work of the team.

"I did really well this year," said sophomore David Hughes. "All of the training I did over the summer and fall paid off this season. Midseason my times hit a plateau, but I just hung in there and swam my best. I had a great taper, dropping times by 5 percent. I hope that next year's taper is as good."





The pre-meet seedings indicated that Lafayette Jeff would win NCC by a big margin, but the Bearcats proved it wrong.



Ryan Fillmann won his second consecutive NCC title and set a school record with a time of 437.52.






