Providing athletic opportunities to more than 100 NHS girls, the GAA offered interscholastic competition in many areas of sports.

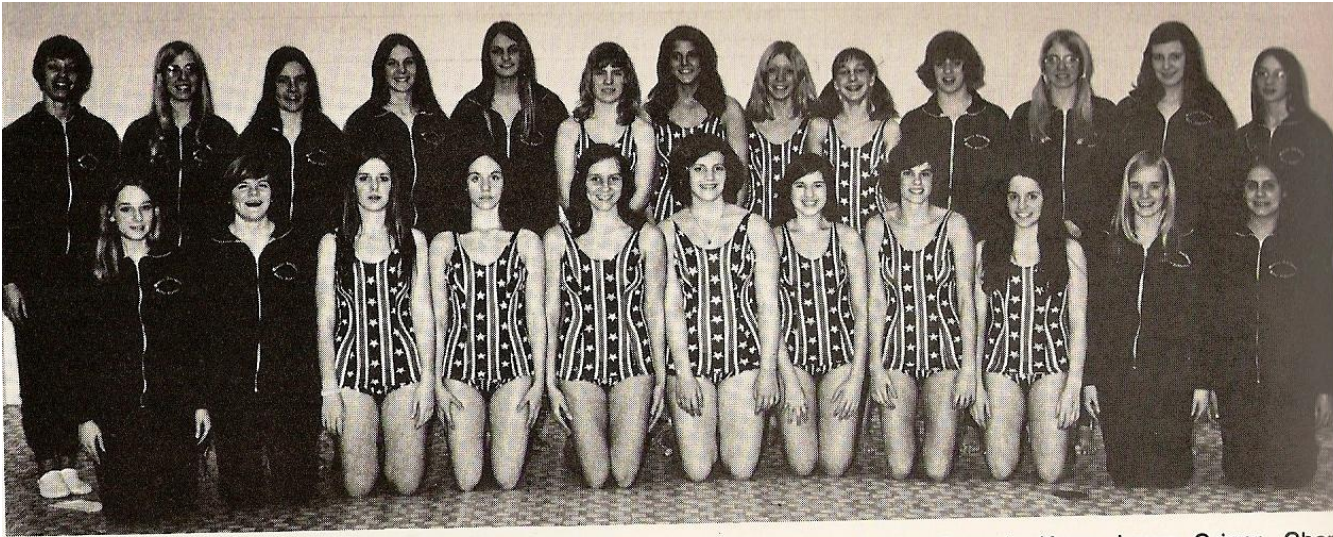

# North Girls Win Swim Sectional

PENDLETON — Placing first in 11 of 13 individual events here Saturday, Muncie North's girls' swim team swept to an impressive victory in the first sanctioned IHSAA girls' swim sectional held at Pendleton Heights High School. Northside scored 453 points during the meet, compared with Richmond's 263 tallies.

Other scores:

Anderson, third, 230; Yorktown, fourth, 143; Connersville, fifth, 124; Noblesville, sixth, 83; New Castle, seventh, 71; and Pendleton Heights, eighth, 65.

**THE TITANS** earned the right to compete in the state IHSAA girls' swim meet, to be held next Friday and Saturday at Warren Central High School, Indianapolis.

North swept both the 200-yard medley and 400-yard freestyle relay events. In the 200-yard medley, the foursome of Cindy DeWitt, Debbie De-

Witt, Liz Albright and Sandy Schneider were clocked in 2:02.1.

New Castle was fourth in the event, with Yorktown finishing sixth. Its quartet consisted of Mary Collins, Tami Garrett, Haller, and Sue Holstein.

In the 400-yard freestyle relay, the winning North aggregation consisted of Jana Allardt, Colleen May, Cindy Parker, and Nancy Darter. Its time was 4:05.1. Finishing fifth was Yorktown, whose swimmers were Donna Douglas, Haller, Heath and Laurie Rowan.

## Titanette Coach Predicts 2nd Place Finish

Muncie North girls' swim coach Janie Wierks isn't content to rest on the overwhelming sectional championship her girls won last Saturday at Pendleton Heights.

"I think we have a great chance to finish second in the state meet," she said at Monday's practice. "I've been checking our sectional times with the 'Top 25' list and it looks good."

On the basis of those same times, it appears that Lafayette Jefferson has the inside track on the first IHSAA girls'

swim title Saturday. Bronco girls are listed among the top times in nearly every event.

Trials will be held at 6 p.m. Friday at Warren Central in all swimming events. Diving trials go at 9 a.m. Saturday and finals in all 14 events at 2 p.m.

"I was especially pleased with Jana Allardt's times in the butterfly," Miss Wierks said. "I feel she has a good chance at first-place finishes in either or both."

She also forecast good things for the Titans' two relay teams. "They both are swim-

ming well, and their chances look good," she said. Both quartets were sectional winners.

The 400-yard freestyle group consists of Jana Allardt, Colleen May, Cindy Parker and Nancy Darter. The 200-yard medley relay team is made up of Cindy DeWitt, Debbie DeWitt, Liz Albright and Sandy Schneider.

Another Northsider with an excellent chance at individual championship is Debbie DeWitt. She finished second to West Lafayette's Jayne Kremer in the 50-yard breast-

stroke by less than two-tenths of a second. Their times have been almost identical all season in both the 50- and 100-yard events.

DeWitt is co-holder of the state GAA mark at 100 yards. She and South Bend Adams' Nancy Walker were both clocked in 1:13.802 last year, but Walker was given the first-place nod, but she graduated last spring.

"Everyone we have left in the meet has an excellent chance of scoring well," Miss Wierks said. The Titans have qualifiers in all but the 50- and 100-yard backstroke events.

DeWitt and Allardt were both double individual winners in the sectional, as were freestyler Colleen May, who won both the 50- and 100-yard races, and Nancy Darter, who won the 400-yard freestyle and the individual medley.

Other individual qualifiers include Liz Albright in the individual medley and 100-yard backstroke; Cindy Parker in the 200- and 400-yard freestyle; Kathy Buennagel in the 200-yard freestyle; Cindy Calvin in the diving; Tami Ruemler in the individual medley; Sandy Schneider in the 50-yard freestyle; Shelly Gouveia in the 50-yard butterfly, and Diana Beebe in the 100-yard freestyle.

"It's a shame the way the schedule worked out," the Titan coach said. "The girls are fired up about basketball and they're fired up about swimming, and it's almost too much."

Swimming will be moved back to the fall next year opposite volleyball, which won't solve many of Janie's problems. Both DeWitts, Albright, Schneider and Parker all were members of the Titans' state championship volleyball team, too.

# North Girls Finish Fourth in State Swim Competition

INDIANAPOLIS — Lafayette picked up only one individual title but emerged Saturday with team balance to win the first Indiana high school girls swimming championship.

Runnerup South Bend Clay came away with three event titles, including two by Jeanne Proteau, one of two double winners in the meet. Clay also won the 200-yard medley relay. Miss Proteau won both the 100-yard butterfly and the 100-yard backstroke.

The other double winner was Shawn McCluskey of South Bend Jackson, taking the 50 and 100 yard backstrokes.

Lafayette's only individual champ was Sara Conkright, who won the 200-yard individual medley.

Munster, which finished third, won three events — the 400-yard freestyle relay, Gayle Johnson in the 50-yard butterfly and Alice Easter in the 100-yard freestyle.

Debbie DeWitt, Northside, who won the 50-yard breaststroke, lost narrowly to Decatur Central's Lynn Guthrie in the 100-yard breaststroke.

In other individual events, Titan results had Nancy Darter twelfth in the 200-yard individual medley; Colleen May, 11th in the 50-yard freestyle; Jana Allardt, eighth in the 50-yard butterfly, and 11th in the 100-yard butterfly; Colleen May, 11th in the 100-yard freestyle, and Nancy Darter, ninth in the 400-yard freestyle.

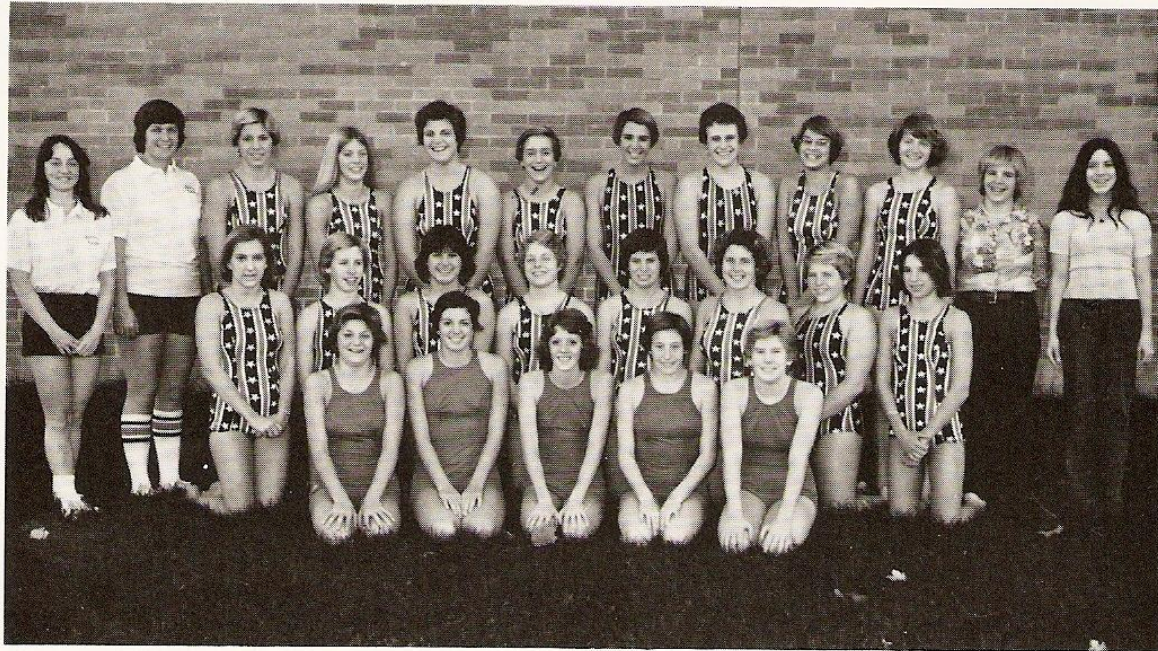

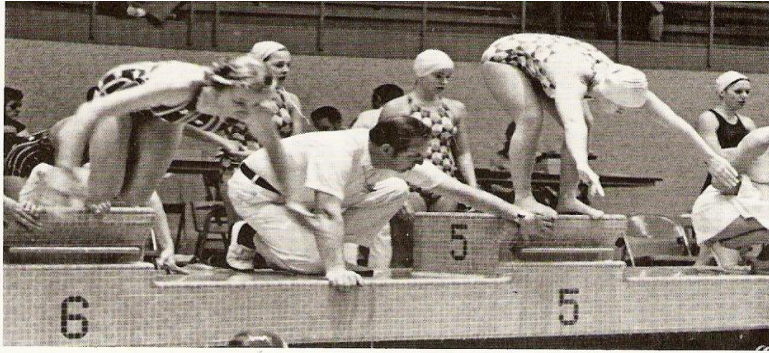

Ending the season with a record of 10-2, the Titan female strokeers were not satisfied until going to sectional, winning, and smashing records in the meantime. Records were broken by Nancy Darter in the 200 yard freestyle, Tami Ruemler in the 200 yard I.M. and 100 yard backstroke, and Alice Darter in the 100 yard butterfly and the 500 yard freestyle.

Winning the state title in the 100 yard butterfly was Alice Darter, who broke the state record during the qualification round with a time of 1:01.818, and then went on to win the finals with a time of 1:02.047.

Other state finishers were Tami Ruemler, Dorice Kelly, Sharon Anderson, and Alice Darter, ninth in the 200 yard medley relay; and Tami Ruemler, ninth in the 200 yard I.M.

Although the girls' swim team consisted of only eleven swimmers and three divers, the team was small but mighty. They lost only to highly rated teams and completed their dual season with a record of 8-4.

Sophomore standout Alice Darter led the team to its fourth consecutive sectional title. Alice set a sectional and school record in the 100 yard butterfly with a time of :59.912. She also set a state record of 1:00.630 in the same event. This is the second time Alice has won the state championship and was only one of two swimmers to defend her state title.

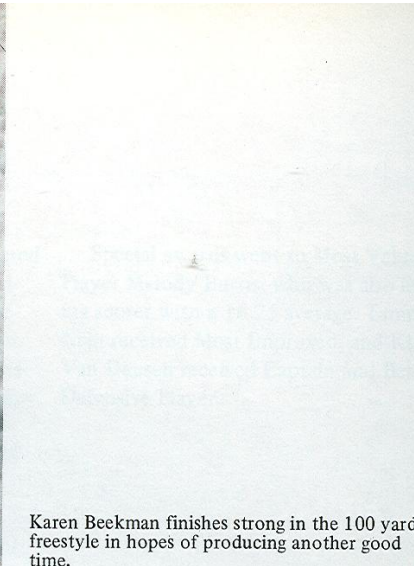
Freshman Kris Peterson also placed in the state meet. She finished eleventh in the 500 freestyle and twelfth in the 200 yard I.M.

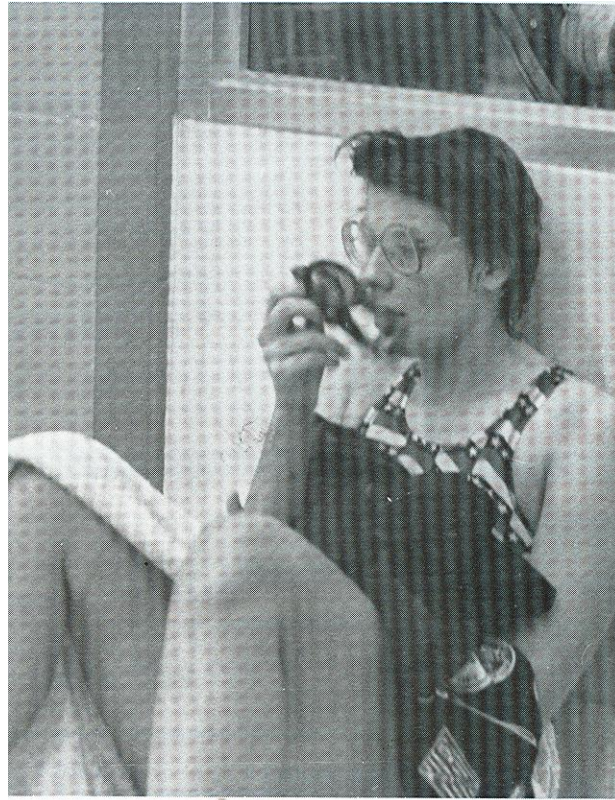

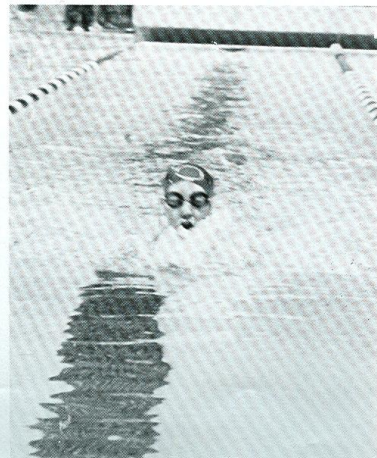
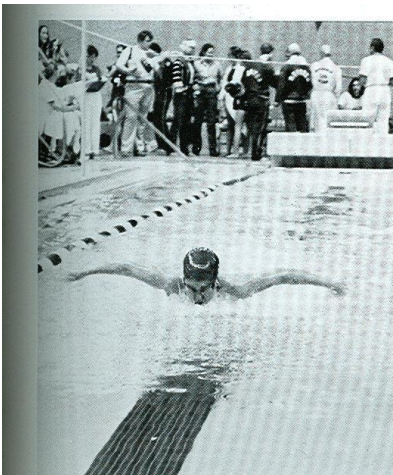


Karen Beekman finishes strong in the 100 yard freestyle in hopes of producing another good time.

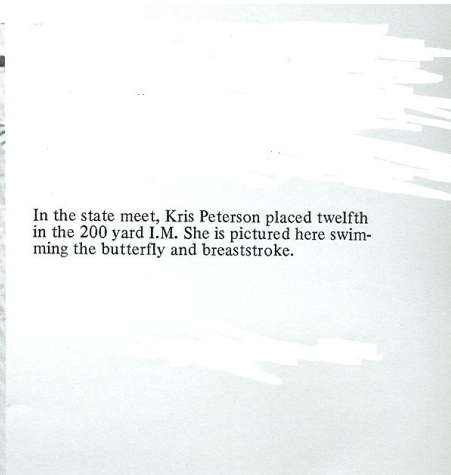




Contemplating the finish of another race is co-captain Diana Beebe, the lone senior on the team.



In the state meet, Kris Peterson placed twelfth in the 200 yard I.M. She is pictured here swimming the butterfly and breaststroke.



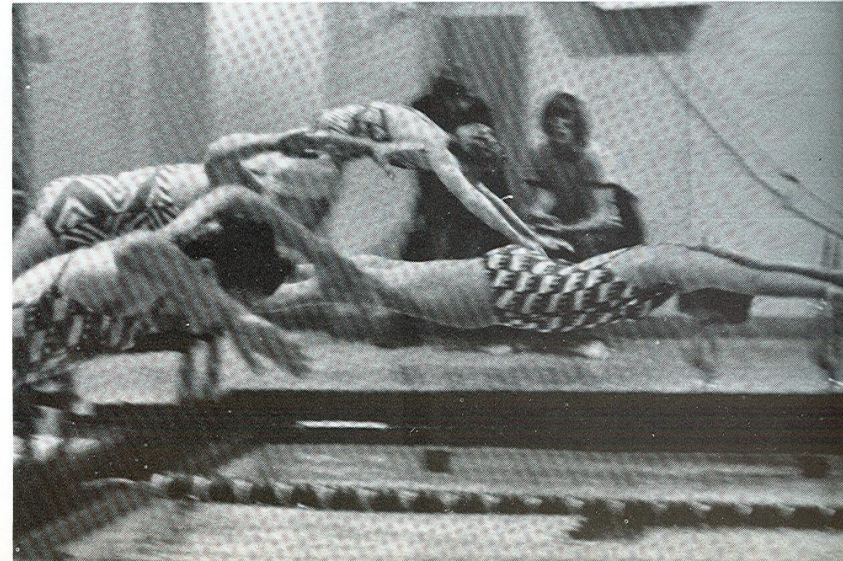
# 1978: 11-4; Sectional Champions

Winning the girls' swim sectional has almost become a tradition at Northside, as the Titan team captured its fifth consecutive sectional title. Under first year coach Cindy lavagnilio, the swimmers were 11-4 in dual meet competition.

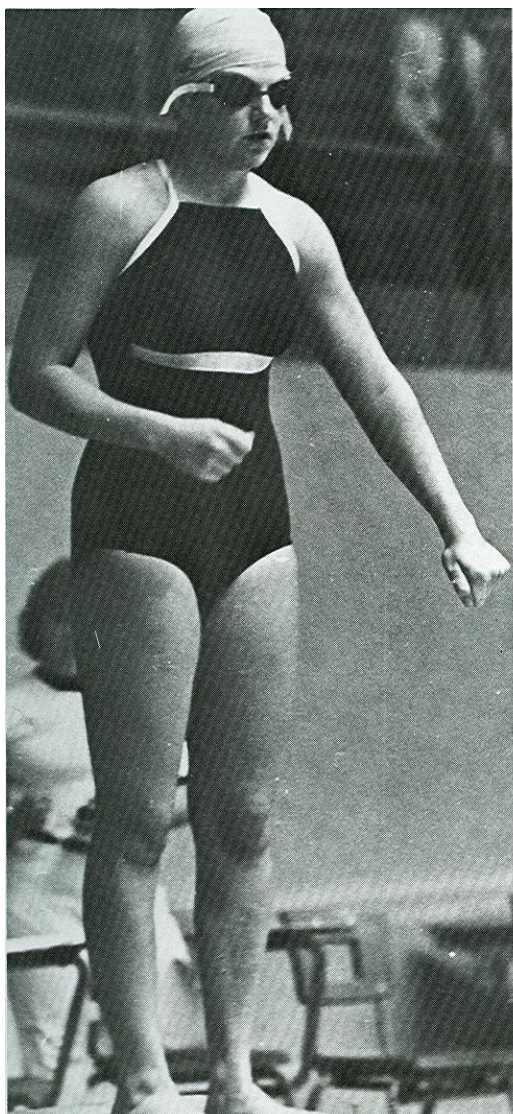
Coach Lavagnilio was pleased with the season, and her only regret was that the Titans were defeated by Anderson. However, North placed one higher than Anderson in state.

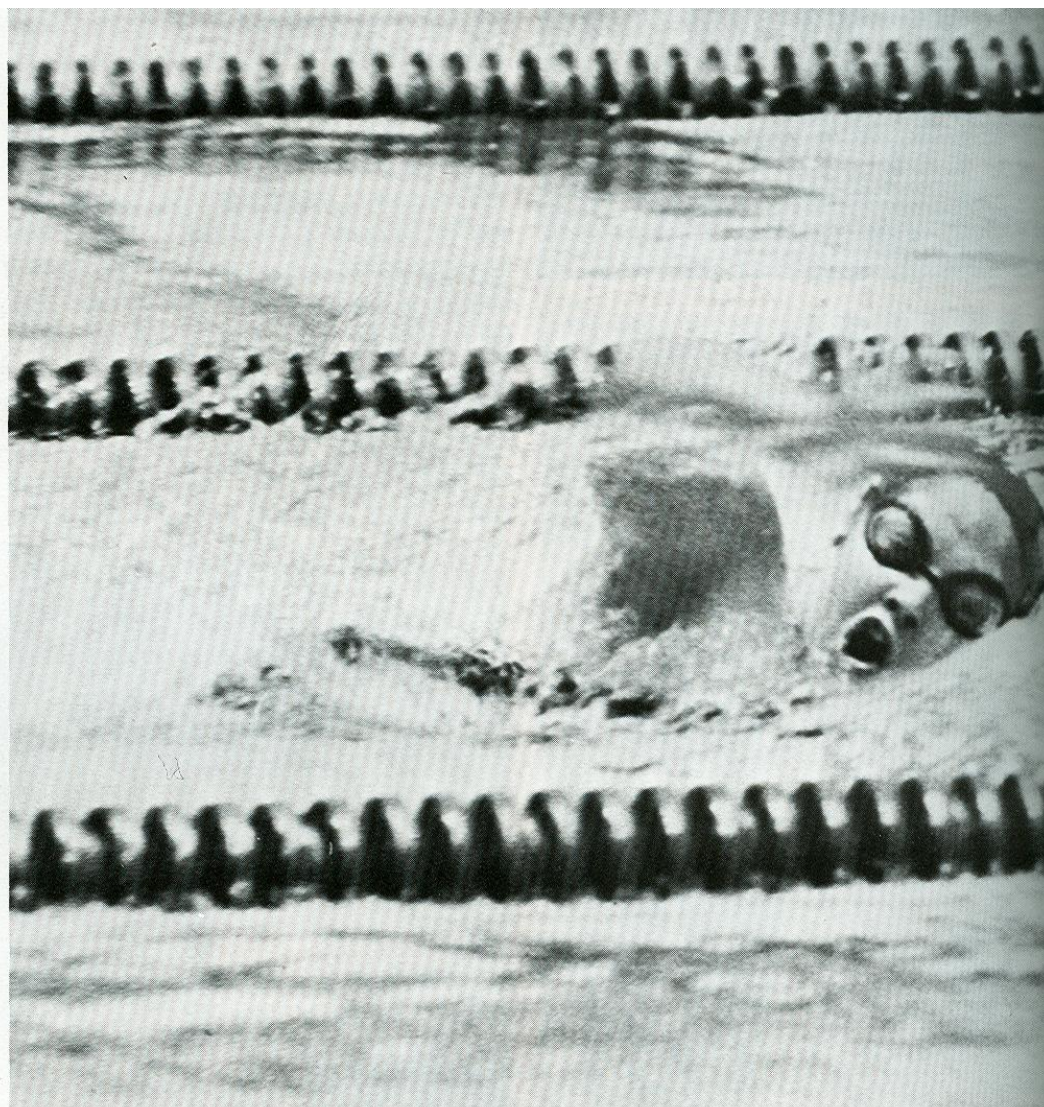
